<p>Breast pumps</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One breast pump kit (manual or electric) with supplies. Beneficiaries can select the breast pump of their choice. TRICARE will reimburse up to a set amount. A prescription is required. • Rental of hospital-grade breast pump. A prescription is required. Hospital-grade breast pumps are covered for as long as use of a hospital-grade breast pump is determined to be medically necessary and appropriate with physician documentation. • Breast pump supplies and replacement items are covered. Note: Supply limitations also apply to hospital-grade breast pumps. (tricare.mil/CoveredServices/IsItCovered/BreastPumpsSupplies) • Breastfeeding lactation: Counseling at no charge – up to six individual outpatient counseling sessions. These classes are in addition to classes during the inpatient maternity stay, outpatient OB visits and well-child visit. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One electric breast pump kit. There is no coverage for manual breast pump kits. A prescription is not required. • Hospital-grade pumps are only covered during an inpatient stay. A prescription is not required. • Breast pump rentals are not covered. • Replacement items/supplies are not covered. • Breastfeeding lactation counseling sessions are unlimited.
<p>Smoking cessation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be at least 17 years of age • Requires a physician’s authorization for third attempt at smoking cessation • TRICARE mail order only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No age limitations • No authorization required • Kaiser Permanente mail order or Kaiser Permanente Pharmacy <p>Note: TRICARE pharmacy programs still available</p>
<p>Vaccines</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaccines are covered at no cost from any TRICARE-authorized provider (copays and cost-shares may apply) • Some covered vaccines are \$0 at participating network pharmacies 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaccines are covered but can only be administered in the provider’s office
